A "sea-trial" will be performed if requested. All systems and their components will be inspected, and if conditions are applicable, checked for operation. The vessel will be surveyed without removal of parts to include fittings, plumbing, wire casings, permanently fastened carpeting, panels, partitions, sheathing, joiner work, deck covering, ground tackle or any other permanently or semi-permanently installed items. Locked or otherwise inaccessible areas will prevent inspection. The charge for the above survey inspection will be \$!!!!. Client agrees that upon delivery of the survey report, either physically or electronically, the fee has been earned and the assignment of this vessel's survey is complete. **From that time forward, any time spent by the Surveyor related to the assignment for any reason shall be billable to the Client at a hourly rate of \$125.00 and reasonable expenses.** The written report will consist of vessel specifications, general comments, and list of equipment.
